- Early detection and treatment
- Evidence based(Nice)
- Team and a service(NOT a centre or a ward!)
- Perinatal Consultant(1 day), relevant junior staff
- Occupational Therapist
- Nurse specialist


Map of ABMU

- Satisfy N.I.C.E. Guidelines No 45
- Replicate the format in Swansea
- Streamlining admin processes





Example

- Married 29 year old woman
- 12 weeks pregnant
- 2nd baby
- Diagnosis of ante natal psychotic depression
- Previous inpatient admission during pregnacy
- On medication
- Was under CMHT
- Seen by outpatient clinic






